### **Dear Champion for Heroes,**

Thank you for your interest in sponsoring or teaming up with the Daisy Walk: Veteran and Military Suicide Awareness walk in your community! The Daisy Walk, hosted by the Veterans Supplemental Support Network (VSSN), is an event to inspire community building, awareness of resources and needs, suicide prevention awareness, and activism.

WHEN TO WALK: Please show your active support to save lives by joining Veterans Supplemental Support Network, Department of Veteran Affairs, our city, school districts, dignitaries, veteran and military service members and their families on **Saturday April 27, 2019** at SYSCO, 15750 Meridian Pkwy, Riverside, CA 92518 across from Riverside National Cemetery for The Daisy Walk. **Check in begins at 7:00 am** and with an opening ceremony at 8:00 am. Most walkers will be **completed** as **early as 10:30 am, however, the event's ending time is approximately 1pm.** 

WHO WALKS: The Daisy Walk is an awareness walk where people of all ages and backgrounds come together to raise awareness and show support for veteran and military family members affected by service connected mental illness (i.e. PTSD, anxiety, depression) which often results in suicide attempts or completion. Walkers can express why they are walking with colored daisies (lapel pins are provided at the walk or they can bring their own daisy) that symbolizes their connection. Red daisies represent a person who has lost a loved one or a friend to suicide.... Gold daisies represents a person who identified with, connected to, or has/have supported a person with suicide ideations.... Blue daisies represent a person who recognizes the struggle and impact of suicide ideation and is in full support of raising awareness.

WHY WE WALK: Your contribution supports VSSN's outreach services that provide direct connection to service and hardship relief for the over half a million veterans, military and families affected by service connected mental illness (PTSD, Anxiety and/or Depression) which often results in suicide and suicide attempts. Our goal is to grow from 500 walkers to at least 1,000 walkers in Riverside County alone in its second year!

**YOUR INVOLVEMENT**: VSSN's goal through Daisy Walk sponsorships is to provide our sponsors with maximum exposure while also helping you build and strengthen brand loyalty among our passionate supporters. 

#### **DAISY WALK ROUTE**

"Daisy Dedication Route" (4 miles) Walk from Meridian Parkway (across from RNC) to the Riverside National Cemetery (RNC) where walkers will meet with a guide who will provide an educational tour to the cemetery's memorials and walkers can place daisies on each memorial wall. After the dedication route. walkers may return to the starting/ending point for lunch, resource vendor information, etc. or choose to continue the "Challenge Route" (8 miles)" towards the March Air Museum. Cyclist are welcome outside of the cemetery.
